## What is a Neighbourhood Plan ?

Neighbourhood Planning is a Community right introduced through the Localism Act 2011

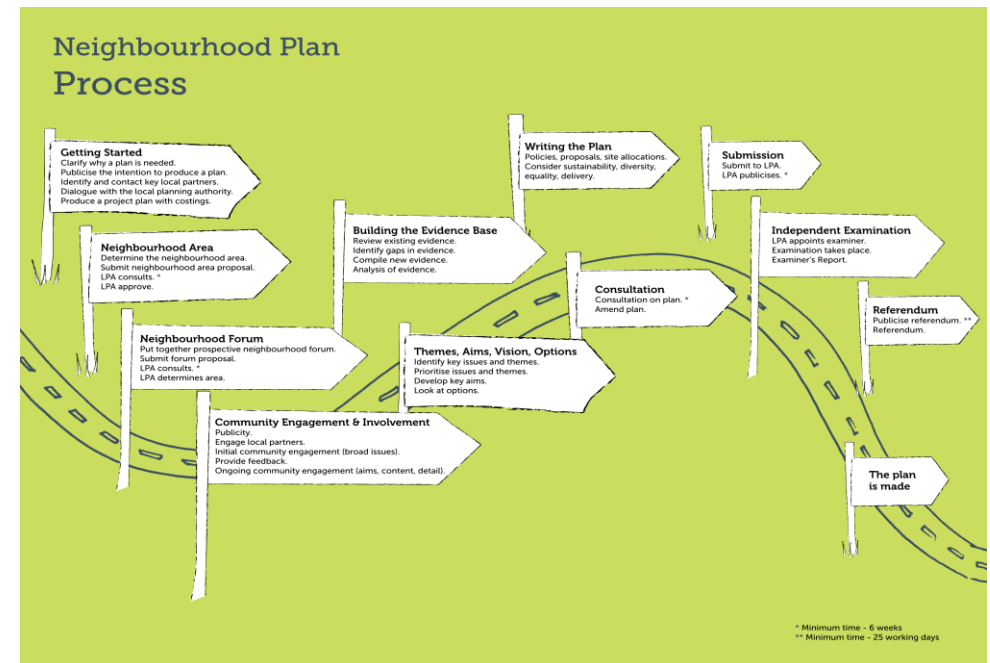
Communities can shape development in their areas through production of Neighbourhood Development Plans, Community Lead Plans or Right to Build Plans

A Neighbourhood Plan is produced by the community, for the Community

Once completed it is vetted by independent Inspectors

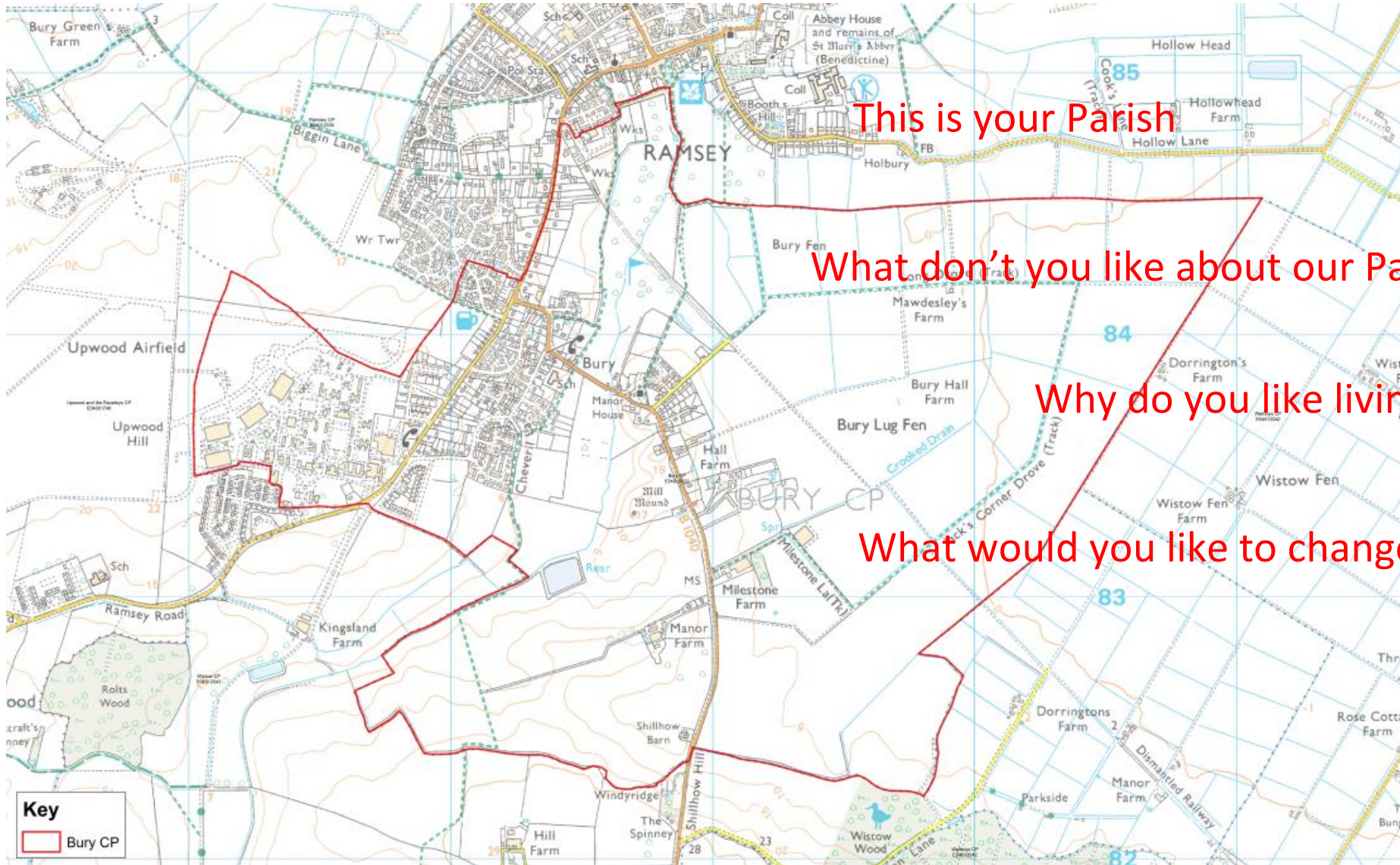
Then 'adopted' by the Local Planning Authority

It's then used as a matter of record and reference for all planning considerations

## Next Steps

To get a small group of people together to work on the plan

To design and distribute a questionnaire to ALL households and collect it

To talk to all interested parties, such as Farms, Users of the Community Hall, the School, Shops and other businesses, developers, other service suppliers like BT, environment and wildlife organisations, in fact **EVERYONE !**

To analysis the questionnaire and publish the results

To write the plan, have it examined and ‘adopted’ by the Local Planning Authority (HDC)
